PURPOSE

The purpose of the Incentive Award Program is to encourage you in your study of the Scriptures by enabling you to add valuable reference books to your library at no cost to yourself. This program is for students who pay for their courses either through the home office or with ECS Associate Instructors in the USA and Canada. Overseas students or those who receive their courses through the scholarship program are not eligible to participate in this program.

HOW IT WORKS

You will be issued a voucher with each multiple unit certificate which you can use for any of the awards listed in this brochure (subject to availability). You may use each voucher as you receive it or accumulate vouchers and submit several at one time. (Vouchers have no cash value and may be exchanged only for the awards listed in this brochure.)

If you do not have enough points you will need to choose another book for which you *do* have sufficient points or wait until the needed vouchers are earned. Additional points cannot be purchased. Orders will only be accepted via mail. A completed order and all original vouchers must be included. (No photocopies will be accepted)

Each multiple unit certificate earned carries a point value as follows:
