SUGGESTED CURRICULUM For HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS (Ages 14-18)

The following suggested curriculum covers four years of study. Depending on the reading level you may want to delay or bring forward some of the courses in the curriculum. The curriculum provides for a variety of book and salvation studies. You may, however, substitute any course according to the needs of the student.
