SUGGESTED CURRICULUM For HOME SCHOOL (Ages 8-17)

The following suggested curriculum covers ten years of study. The courses in the early years are designed to give a basic introduction to the Bible. Depending on the reading level you may want to delay or bring forward some of the courses in the curriculum. The curriculum provides for a variety of book and salvation studies. You may, however, substitute any course according to the needs of the student.
